HOW TO REACH THE VENUES

GLASGOW GREEN and SIR CHRIS HOY VELODROME & EMIRATES ARENA

Glasgow Green – the city's oldest and arguably most iconic park – hosts the BMX Freestyle and Trials events. *Glasgow Green* is situated on the banks of the Clyde to the southwest of the city centre. NCN 75 passes through the park, whilst NCN 756 lies a short distance to the south.

Track Cycling events will take place in the *Sir Chris Hoy Velodrome*, with Cycle Ball and Artistic Cycling competitions taking place in the adjacent *Emirates Arena*, in Glasgow's East End. NCN 75 provides a traffic-free link for cyclists along the banks of the Clyde, between the city centre and both venues.

APPROXIMATE DISTANCES AND TRAVEL TIMES FROM QUEEN STREET STATION

GLASGOW GREEN: 1.4 miles (2.2 km)

by bicycle: 15 mins
on foot: 25 mins

SIR CHRIS HOY VELODROME
and EMIRATES ARENA: 3 miles (4.8 km)

by bicycle: 20 mins
on foot: 50 mins
